NIOS is providing a number of Vocational, Life Enrichment and community oriented courses besides General and Academic Courses at Secondary and Senior Secondary level. It also offers Elementary level Courses through its Open Basic Education Programmes (OBE). Government of India through a gazette notification vested NIOS with the authority to examine and certify learners registered with it upto pre degree level courses.

Exploring Opportunities Towards Formal Education System

implemented by National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with the aim of providing primary and upper primary level education through alternate means of open schooling to those who are not able to go to a formal school or have dropped out of school.

Manovikas School for Inclusion (MSI) (under the aegis of Manovikas Charitable Society (MCS)) is providing the OBE facilities for the all learners including children with developmental disabilities, school drop outs, slum marginalized, BPL groups etc.

We are widening the opportunities for the learners who attain any special school, home tuition, care and rehabilitation programme, mainstream school may register at MSI under OBE programme. The special school or concern teacher/tutor has to identify the level of learners and recommend for the admission in any class from I to VIII and continue to impart the education support services for them. The learner may need to attain Study Centre of NIOS at Manovikas for Registration, I-Card, Study Materials, Counselling, Examination only.



Features

1. Extended registration upto 5 yrs. to complete any level.
2. A learner has a Language as medium of study.
3. There is no upper age limit for any learner.
4. The learning package consists of Language(s), Maths, Science, Social Science as academic subjects and one vocational subject. A learner can choose the Vocational Subject from the given list offered by NIOS.
5. The examination would be conducted two times a year. A learner can take the first examination for any level after one year of admission. Subsequently the learner can appear in examinations till he/she is registered.

The feature of credit accumulation is available for OBE learners.

Level

1. Level A equivalent to standard III of the formal school system.
2. Level B equivalent to standard V of the Formal school system.
3. Level C equivalent to standard VIII of the format school system.

Target Learners at MSI for OBE

1. Learners with developmental disabilities studying in special schools
2. Learners with specific learning difficulties unable to cope up in mainstream education system
3. Learners with physical or mental disabilities under the care and rehabilitation programme
4. Learners attending home based schooling/home tuition by special aid teachers
5. School dropouts
6. Dropouts of NFE programmes
7. Neo literates of National Literacy Mission's Continuing Education Scheme
8. Girls and women, marginalized groups, SC/ST, BPL groups, first generation learners
9. Out of school children and adults, etc.

Age Group

The programme is being conducted specially for adults in the following age groups:

- 6 to 14 yrs age group (as per orders of MHRD, OBE is available for 6-14 yrs age group till 2013)
- Adults of 14+ yrs. and above



Curriculum and Materials

The curriculum for OBE is based on the National Curriculum Framework.

Recognition of talent and virtues are also given a place.

Sample learning materials have been developed by NIOS, which can be obtained from MSI web site www.manovikas.co.in

Manovikas Study Centre may provide you the text books on nominal cost.

In case of vocational subjects, the Manovikas will provide appropriate subject code from NIOS

Manovikas Study Centre may help the special schools or tutors in the development of learning materials for different local specific subjects.

Compulsory Subjects for Different Level

Eligibility for Certification obtaining pass in 1 Language + 3 Subjects = 4 Subjects are necessary. Maximum marks is 100 and minimum passing is 33.

Academic Duration and Calendar

The duration of each level A/B/C is for one year. Once the learners registered at any level the registration is valid for five years. Within the five years of period the learner can pass the subjects as per their convenient and their credit will be accumulated in the final mark sheet.

The evaluation will have three components :

- **Academic**
- **Qualities and**
- **Talents.**

The academic components will be tested, where ever required, through written and oral examination with accommodation.

The qualities and talents will be tested through activities carried out through the teaching learning process.

These activities will be graded as external assessment and the awards given on the final certificate.

Scheme of Studies

1. Under the different levels, academic and vocational education would be offered.
2. Language can be Hindi, English, Urdu or regional language
3. AHPL/ one pre vocational skills for 6-14 age group and one vocational subject for adult age group are compulsory.
4. Learners can take upto a total of eight subjects of which 6 may be academic subjects
5. A completion certificate will be given when a learner passes the prescribed eligibility criteria for a subject.



Examination

- ✓ The learner registering for the first time would be required to study for one year before he/she can appear for an examination. Subsequently the MANovikas will hold examinations upto two times in a year for its learners.
- ✓ The examination papers for level A and B shall be 100 marks of two and half hours duration while that for Level C shall be for 3 hours and 100 marks.
- ✓ Medium of examination may be Regional Language/ Hindi/ English.
- ✓ The NIOS allows the learners to accumulate credits by clearing one subject at a time within a period of 5 years.
- ✓ A joint certificate would be issued by the MSI and NIOS.
- ✓ The examination shall be conducted by Manovikas, Study Centre as per the date and schedule set by NIOS.
- ✓ Learners must register for the examination along with Examination Form and Fees.

For the April Semester Examination will be conducted in 1st /2nd week of March.

For the October Semester Examination will be conducted in 1st /2nd week of August.

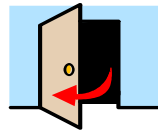
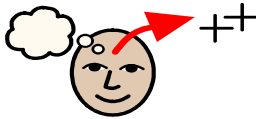

April Semester :

Last date of Application is March 15

October Semester :

Last Date of Application is August 16

Application for Appearing in Examination

Learners must register for the examination along with Examination Form and Fees

For April Semester

Examination will be conducted in 1st /2nd week of March.

The Examination Form must be submitted before December 30th.

For October Semester

Learners Examination will be conducted in 1st /2nd week of August.

The Examination Form must be submitted before May 30th.
