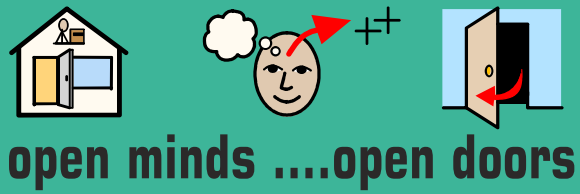

## Training Programme on Skill for Counselling Parents of Students with Special Needs

Changing the attitude of parents is the hallmark of counselling program. Counsellors need to deal with a broad spectrum of issues while counselling to the parents of the special needs. Sometimes parents have trouble bonding i.e., establishing a close and loving relationship with a child having disability. The main role of the counsellor should be for the removal of misconceptions and false beliefs about the disability and to provide social support to the parents at the initial and subsequent counselling stages. Parental adjustment with the children with disability requires a good foundation in basic problem solving skills. Moreover, the counselling should be directed toward the problems of future care. The Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) on "Skill for Counselling of Students with Special Needs" will equip you to teach parents new skills and support the development of their children with disabilities. The complete three days training programme is considerably based on empirical evidence supporting parents counselling approach.

### The objectives of the training programme on Skill for counselling are:

- (a) Allowing parents to choose when to learn new skills;
- (b) To teach parenting strategies; and
- (c) Teaching parents in a skilful and individualized manner
