Independent Living

Independent living can be defined as the ability of a person with a disability to perform self-care activities and participate in the process of self-determination in the least restrictive environment (Wright, 1980).

The philosophy of independent living is based on honouring the rights of people with disabilities to equal opportunities, empowerment, and self-respect. This is in absolute congruence with the fact that people with disabilities are experts in their own lives, and that they have the right to assume full control over their lives. The true motto is to ensure that people with disabilities have the same rights and choices as their counterparts without disabilities (Nosek, 1997; Ratzka, 1997).

A sense of unity and self-confidence gradually developed, largely as a result of the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, Article 19 'Living independently and being included in the community' incorporated. States Parties to this Convention recognize the equal right of all persons with disabilities to live in the community, with choices equal to others, and shall take effective and appropriate measures to facilitate full enjoyment by persons with disabilities of this right and their full inclusion and participation in the community.
