## **Manovikas Charitable Society**

Manovikas and its slogan 'AUM TAT SAT' indicates threefold metaphysical development of man and mind: that is Being-Consciousness-Bliss through Sacrifices (yajna), charities (dana), austerities (tapas).



Manovikas Charitable Society (MCS) is working in the area of disabilities, education and rehabilitation for more than two decades. The organization strongly believes that persons with intellectual and development disabilities (IDD) need to be treated equal irrespective of their disabilities proactive efforts are being made by the organization to mainstream them through Education, Care and Advocacy.

Different projects undertaken to meet the mission and vision of the organisation are briefed in this profile.

### **Education**

## Encouraging independence through education: Supporting employable skills



#### Manovikas School for Inclusion (MSI):

Students with IDD at MSI are valued and imparted education up to standard XII through the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) so that they become prospective candidates for college/higher education.

### Manovikas Institute for Higher Education (MIHE):

MIHE is one of the colleges in India for the persons with IDD for sustainable employment, offers admission to job oriented Certificate and Diploma level programmes.

MIHE is involved in development of manpower in Social Work and Rehabilitation Sector recognized by IGNOU, NIOS, and RCI. The institute conducts thirty (30) different programmes for nearly 500 learners.

### Manvik-LBIIHM:

With the support of Lakshya Bhartee Institute of International Hotel Management (LBIHM), Manovikas has started one of the inclusive higher education institutions, 'Manvik' in India. The students with IDD are learning vocational skills and knowledge along with mainstream peers in hospitality, retail and IT sectors.

### **Aaryaman Center for Excellence (ACE):**

With the support from Home of Hope Inc. (HOH) the Aaryaman Centre for Excellence (ACE) was established at Manovikas in the memory of Aaryaman, who himself had disability but he was very friendly with I-pad and computers. The ACE lab is providing training in computer technology and promoting the education of children with special needs, opening doors to employment world.

### **Skill Development Programme:**

Manovikas provides skill training in hospitality, retail, IT, health and beauty care under the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF).



Disability is a result of an impairment that may be cognitive, developmental, intellectual, mental, neurological, physical, sensory, or some combination of these. It substantially affects a person's life activities and may be present from birth or occur during a person's lifetime.

#### Facts:

Roughly 5.1% of all children (93 million) live with a moderate or severe disability and 0.7%, or 13 million children, live with severe difficulties. Persons with disabilities are 3-4 times more likely to experience iscrimination, physical and sexual violence and neglect than non-disabled children.

Supporting a way of life: Providing a safe environment



### Aarambh Child Care Center (A3C):

Children from economially weaker sections are most venerable likely to experience developmental delays than other children. A3C support for the habilitation of children's readiness to gain admission in mainstream schools and work in partnership with families and communities to offer consistent, loving care for young children.

### Manolaya Residential Care Centre (MRCC):

Manolaya offers affordable, accessible living arrangements (residential and respite care) along with the support needed to meet each person's unique needs. We promote personal decision making, meaningful community involvement and assist individuals to develop and maintain independence in their everyday lives.

### Quality of Life (QoL) Centers:

Manovikas has two QoL Centers, Saath-Saath Community Based Rehabilitation and Bliss of Life (BoL). QoL Centers provide a safe, stimulating, creative day center within a caring and nurturing environment in the community for young and adult persons with high support needs (severe, and multiple disabilities) who are hardly getting benefit from further educational intervention or training programmes.
